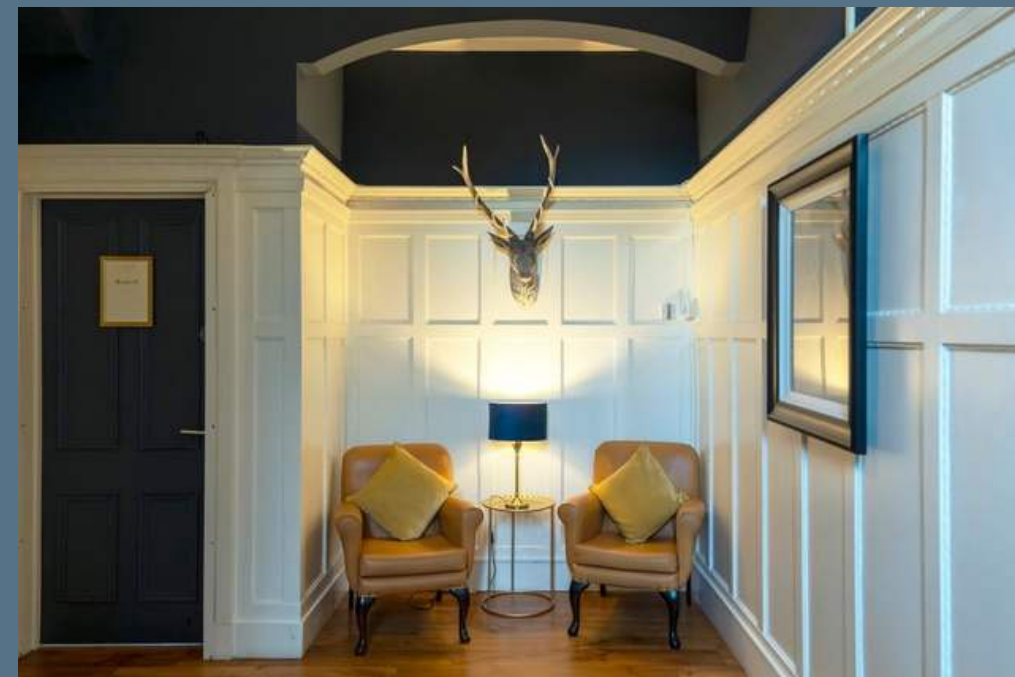

The care home offers

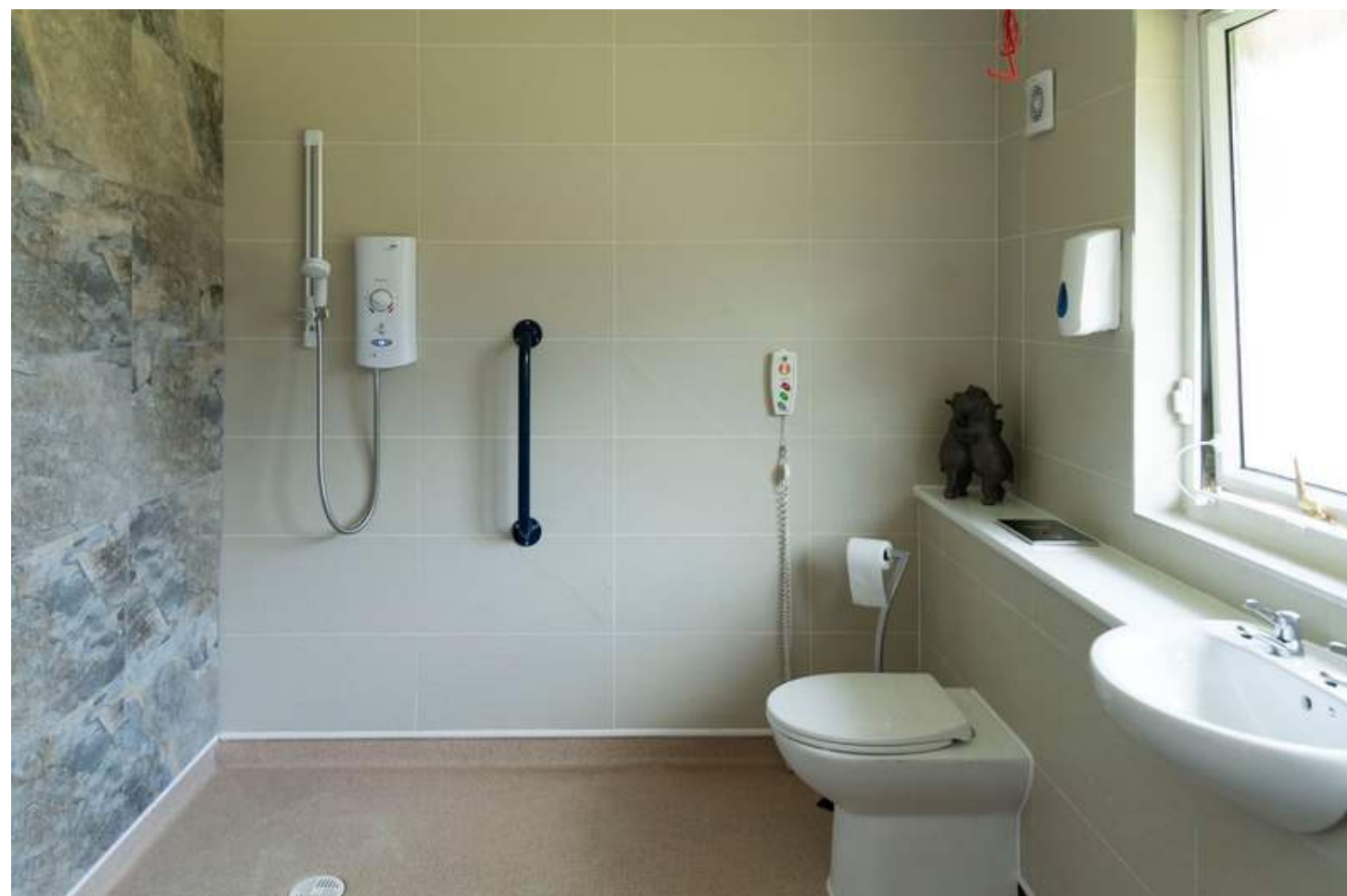
- 50 private bedrooms set across two bright and accessible floors
- Five lounge and dining rooms, each offering a unique atmosphere for socialising, dining and relaxation
- Private gardens with direct access to Alexander Hamilton Memorial Park
- On-site hairdressing salon and cinema room for wellbeing and entertainment
- In-house laundry and housekeeping services for convenience and comfort
- In-room sensor and alarm systems with personalised settings based on each resident's care needs
- Accessibility features including lifts, ramps and comprehensive call systems
- Nearby public transport, making visiting easy for family and friends



Bedrooms

Each bedroom within Avonhaugh Nursing Home provides a bright, airy living space for residents to make their own. All rooms have been designed with neutral, calming colours but residents also have the option to decorate their room to suit individual taste.

All bedrooms are accessible for wheelchair use and are equipped with specialised profile beds, a chair, wardrobe, drawers, bedside table and lighting.
